## F.A.Q.s

- Are there COVID-19 guidelines we must follow?
  - To ensure the health and safety of all participants, Noah's Bandage Run is working with the city of Overland park to mandate certain COVID guidelines. At this time, masks must be worn while walking around the premise before and after the race. There will be multiple start waves to alleviate crowding. Masks must be worn while in line to start the race and may be removed once the racer passes the starting cone while on the course. As soon as runners cross the finish line, they then need to put their mask back on. Rather than passing out cups of water along the course and after the race, disposable water bottles will be provided, should a race participant want one.
- When does online registration close?
  - Online registration will be open until 7 a.m. on race day.

# RACE DAY INFO

- Can I register at Packet Pick-up?
  - Yes, you can register during the hours and at the locations of Packet Pick-Up for \$40. This may be paid by cash, check or credit card.
- Can someone else pick up my packet?
  - Yes. In order for someone to pick up your packet, they must present your first and last name at packet pick-up.
- May I get a refund?
  - Unfortunately, all entries are non-refundable and non-transferable. After we have received and accepted your entry, we cannot issue a refund, allow you to transfer your number to anyone else or change your registration to next year.
- Bandage Drop Off
  - Don't forget to bring your fun/colorful bandages that you have collected to the Noah's Bandage Project tent. It will be located next to the main stage on tent row.

- Aid Station
  - One aid station will be placed at the center of the course. Water will also be provided at the end of the race.
- Restrooms
  - There will be one bank of Port-a-Potties at the East end of tent row.
- Family Meeting Place
  - If you get separated from your family, or need first aid supplies, a tent will be located at the West end of tent row, near registration.
- Medical
  - Johnson County Med Act will be on site to provide emergency medical attention.
- Safety
  - Races are limited to registered participants only. No rollerblades, bicycles, skateboards or dogs are allowed on the course. Non-compliance will result in disqualification. The course monitors and volunteers will control traffic during the race. All runners should always exercise caution during the race. Overland Park Police department will be on site.

# RACE DAY INFO

- Timing Chip
  - Timing will be used for all racers. Runners' chips will be included on the race bibs. Your official time, as clocked by your chip when you cross the finish line, will be available at the registration tent kiosks and online at [www.noahsbandagerun.com](http://www.noahsbandagerun.com).
- In Case of Severe Weather
  - In the event of severe or inclement weather on race morning, Noah's Bandage Run 5K will implement a protocol to ensure the safety of all participants, volunteers, staff, and spectators. Only in the most severe and dangerous of circumstances will the race director consider canceling the event. The event staff will communicate with the participants through the start/finish sound system. The sound systems will not be turned off unless forced by conditions. Refunds are not available.
